Old Business:

Fuel Report: 146 gallons used this month which was 107 gallons less than last month.

Hot Water Issue: quote was gotten from Lowe's for 399.00 for Whirlpool Central Water Filtration for entire house. Wanda will contact Curwensville Heating and Plumbing and Bi-Lo Supply for estimated quotes. John will contact Jeff Shaffer and H &H Hardware for quotes as well. We will make a decision before next meeting.

<u>Solar Ordinance</u>: Ordinance was approved with the latest changes. Jim approved and signed 2nd by Dave approved and signed. John in favor approved and signed. Wanda adopted the ordinance this 13th day of August 2025. Ordinance 25-8. Wanda will check to see if it has to be in the paper or if can be on the website for public notification.

<u>Palco Power System</u>: It was voted against obtaining the extended warranty for the generator. Clarification was explained by Wanda. All (3) supervisors were in favor of not purchasing the extended warranty past the 5 years that came with the purchase.

Painting: The guys are planning on doing the floors in the next few months before it gets cold. Wanda did get a price on the garage floor paint kit for 179.00 which will cover approximately 450-500sq ft. It is estimated to cost approximately 716.00, Wanda will also check a price on a floor sander at Reed Brother's. The floors will need to be sanded in order for the paint to adhere. It was suggested that they try a small area first in the closet. The walls will be done before the floor gets done.

LSA Grant: Wanda will be working on grant to purchase a new Grader. Case did give us an estimated quote of 318,814.00, the opening for applying for the grant is September 1, 2025- November 30, 2025.
