Review of Minutes from January Meeting: Jim motioned to approve the minutes, 2nd by John with all in Favor.

Treasurer Report: John motioned to approve, 2nd by Jim with all in favor to approve the treasurer report

Bill List: John motioned to approve the bill list, 2nd by Jim with all in favor. It was also decided that the bills will no longer be signed. Just the Bill List only, the bills will be reviewed but no need to sign.

Old Business:

Fuel Report: 345 Gallons Use

Painting: Floors still need painted. Dave did buy the paint.

Education: Wanda attended the Year End reporting Class on 1/12/2026. Wanda also attended the Clearfield County Conservation Meeting to push and speak for the Jerry Run Grant.

Liberty Fire: The hood still needs welded and bell needs placed. John said they would probably have to do it themselves. Wanda agreed to call Halvo's Mobil Welding in Morrisdale to get a quote.

Quote from CKG Area Authority: Reviewed the quote and it was decided that the engineering costs and the project cost was too much for the township to bear. Wanda will try to get a grant now that she knows how much it will cost. She also reached out to Mr. Lopez from Clearfield County Water Authority to see if they got the board's approval to continue with their engineering studies.

New Business:

Erie Insurance Grant: The grant was declined because we were located close enough to the Erie Headquarters.

Grant Awarded: The grant for 10,651.00 to tar and chip 300' of Jerry Run was approved from the bottom of 879. Midland Asphalt will be doing this job for us in the spring.

Cabins: The cabins in the flood zone are now being handled for further action by Brian Ruble and Jack Carns.

Big Buck Lumber: They have been contacted and via phone call and they are happy to discuss fixing Hansey Road. They will meet with the Supervisor's when there isn't any snow on the roadway.

Lezzer Lumber: We received a quote from Lezzer Lumber for new keypads for the social hall but the price was rather expensive. We will table that for discussion at a later time. They will be down to fix the garage maintenance door when it gets nicer out.

CD Renewal: The Goshen Township Water CD was renewed at a rate of 3.65% on 2/7/2026.

Educational Opportunities: Wanda discussed what was available and at this time nobody wanted to attend any of the workshops.

Stone Bids: Stone Bids have gone out and we will open the closed sealed bids at the next regular meeting.

Township Audit: Wanda claims there were some issues that need fixed before the audit can take place. Terri Cunkle will be working with Wanda to correct these book keeping issues.
