

Goshen Township Meeting Minutes

June 10th, 2026

Public Comment: Linda Nelson was here to discuss her subdivision on her property and Wanda was able to give her the GSI Map of the property lines, Ron Thorp was her on behalf of Subdivision for Curry & Associates for Land Subdivision for Hainsey Property. Stanley Mayhew discussed a pond being placed on the property.

Secretary's Report: Read by Wanda Rougeux motion was made by John, seconded by Jim to accept the minutes of meeting

Treasurer's Report: Reviewed and motion was made by John, seconded by Jim to accept the treasurer's report and all bills signed.

Old Business:

Discussion regarding the grill hood and floors for the social hall. Dave said they will have to make plans to get the grill fixed because inspector will be coming in August to have it inspected.

Road Work on Jerry Run from the Grant from the Conservation District, Dave will meet with representative, Rachel Kester on June 17th @ 10:00am. We will call Midland to get put on the schedule.

It was voted on with all in favor to have PPG get Jefferson Paving to come fix the road that PPG tore up. Wanda will email Josh in the morning to advise him of our decision.

Dumpster for resident cleanup was tabled from last month's meeting. It was decided that we could try it in the fall and see how it goes. We can advertise it for our area residents. It might be a good incentive to help people clean up the place.

New Business:

Road Closure- It was noted that the Goshen Road will be closed for bridge repair for the next few months.

Educational opportunities were offered but was declined by all members.

Update from Jack Carns regarding the Floodplain Cabins Noncompliance, Wanda reached out to him to get an update he said he was told that the cabins were getting sold.

Repairs to Hainsey Road, the Supervisors decided this would be done tentatively the end of June.

Data Ordinance, Greg Martell wanted to know if we could put something regarding a "Closed Loop System" in the Ordinance. Wanda said that she will contact Bill Shaw in the morning to see if he can add this into the Ordinance. Jeff Prince also commented and thanked Wanda for the hard work and good job in preparing so quickly a rough draft for the Ordinance.

New "Distracted Driving Law "went into effect on June 5th, 2026.

Roadway Report:

Road Bonds Issued: 1 Road Bond Issued to Glenn O. Hawbaker to remove large amount of topsoil at the Mineral Basin Project.

Permits Issued: 1 sent to MoValley COG to tear down an old house and 1 for demo of an agricultural barn.

Wanda also states no land transfers noted for the month of May.

Complaints:

A resident complained that the Clearfield Borough is no longer allowing the recyclables to be accepted by outside residents. They wanted to know if we would consider a recycle trailer. Wand checked into it and because it would cost 750.00 per pull. It was rejected. Wanda did give out some information of places they could go to recycle and the booklets were given out and available to the public at the office and she will put it on the website.

A resident wanted to know the outcome of the dilapidated trailer on Jerry Run Road belonging to Steven Jury. What is being done about it? Uncertain who owns it. John mentioned to see if we could go tear it down and charge it to the owner for the township tearing it down. Wanda will have to check on that with the attorney.

A resident complained about a clogged pipe, wondered what the plans are for fixing it? The supervisors state that water is running through it but will need some attention to fix it correctly.

A resident complained about Bob Plubell, if he ever got permits and inspections for his sheds in the Floodplain? They want us to enforce the rules that everyone else has to abide by. Wanda will investigate and if unable to find the documentation will send out a letter to him to address the matter.

Complaint was made by DCNR that a resident, the Rishel's, who recently bought a camp on leased property did not get a permit from the township. They are putting additions on to the camp. A camp affidavit was not filed as well. Wanda will send them a letter as well.

Correspondence

We got a letter from Ginny Marcille-Kerslake, who is a senior organizer for the Food & Water Watch Pennsylvania, advising our residents to contact your state representatives and let them know they oppose House Bill 502 and House Bill 2151. These bills represent buildouts of hyperscale Data Centers.

Received a letter from PSP, all fines going forward will becoming EFT's going forward

Midland informed us that CRS-2 went up .26 cents last month.

Multimodal Transportation Fund are due by July 31, 2026. Wanda asked if we would want to apply for anything.

Letter was sent to William Enterprise to let them know that they will no longer be our provider as of January for the CDL and non-CDL drug testing. We are using PSSAT's.
