

Goshen Township Meeting Minutes

November 12, 2025

Public Comment: Paul Serena came to meeting wanting to know what was going on with the water issue he brought to meeting last month. Wanda told him that she contacted Clearfield Municipal Authority they are going to get the engineers involved and see if it is possible to supply the remaining residents, CKG Area Authority a letter was written to the board and mailed, Contacted US Water that supplies Penelec no response as of yet. Kristin Shoenecker, a Penn State Intern, wanted to observe the meeting pertaining to after effects of the solar energy to the community. We suggested that she speak to Greg Martell, he is very knowledgeable about the solar energy in the area. Chase Johnson, resident that wanted the supervisors to come look where his fiace and he was going to put a new double wide in place of existing trailer. The Supervisors, told them the setbacks from the road and to keep it in the property boundaries.

Fuel Report: 89 gallons used

Painting: The walls are still not done. The floor paint that Wanda got still is not done. David was supposed to get the paint, still not done. Wanda said we really need to get these procrastinations taken care of.

Education: Wanda attended some classes, Dirt & Gravel Grant Class. She also attended DED Grant Workshop.

Liberty Fire: The social hall still needs to have the welding done. Purchasing Mig Welder for the township is still under discussion until next month meeting. Wanda states we need to finish the kitchen hood job instead of procrastinating.

New Business:

CD RENEWAL: The Water Authority CD is up for renewal it will renew at a lower interest rate of 3.85% because the feds cut the interest rate. We will renew it again for another 3 months at MidPenn Bank. Approval was made to renew- 1st Dave- 2nd by John with all in favor.

Grants: Wanda has applied for (3) LSA Grants thus far. The closing date will be 11/30/2025. (1) Dirt & Gravel Grant for Jerry Run Road for tar and chipping (1) Erie Insurance Grant for playground equipment. She hopes to do (2) more grants,

Fire Hydrant Installation-it was placed by the Eden Church. Thanks to the townships help along with the CKG crew it has been placed.

Christmas Party: The Township will host 1st Annual Christmas Party. It will take place on December 6th at 4pm. Approval was granted by the board to provide Meat & Cheese Tray, Rolls, Fruit & Veggie Tray. Wanda is in charge of the party all are welcome within the township and down river residents are welcome as well. Bring a covered dish potluck.

Education: Educational opportunities given but nobody seemed interested in any of the classes offered.

Letters: 2 letters were sent to (2) area residents regarding being in violation of the Flood Plain by FEMA requested by the supervisors due to other residents' complaints, action needed to be taken. It is also a violation to operate a business in a Flood Plain according to Ordinances.

Congratulations: Jim was nominated by the township for another 6 years as Supervisor.

Right to Know Request: (1) Right to Know Request was sent to a company in Washington, DC.

Budget Approval: The budget was approved with no tax increases in our township, all in favor. We will remain at 2.25% at this time. The budget notice will be placed in the legal advertisement in the newspaper and will be available for viewing purposes in township office for the next 20 days. It will be adopted at the December meeting. Dates for the rest of the year monthly meetings was also set with approval, all in favor. The Organizational Meeting will be on January 5th @ 10:00am , with the January Monthly Meeting immediately following. All other monthly meetings will remain the same, 2nd Wednesday of every month at 7:00pm.
